EPISTLE

The Lesson from the Book of the Apocalypse of blessed John the Apostle.

IN those days: Behold, I John saw another Angel ascending from the East, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four Angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth, and the sea, saying: Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads. And I heard the number of them which were sealed, and there were sealed an hundred and forty and four thousand, of all the tribes of the children of Israel. After this I beheld, and lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues: stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands: and cried with a loud voice, saying: Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.
